

# BOISE CITY SCRIP

The Boise City Scrip Program is subsidized by the City of Boise and managed by Senior Solutions. A scrip coupon is used like cash with local taxi cab companies.

To be eligible for Boise City scrip, an individual must have a valid scrip I.D. card. To qualify for an I.D. card, a person must be 15 years of age or older, live within the Boise City limits, and have a permanent disability to such a degree that inhibits his/her ability to drive a vehicle. Physician's verification is required.

The eligibility process can be completed and I.D. cards obtained at the Senior Solutions office, 3010 West State Street, Suite 120, Boise. To obtain an I.D. card, an individual must make an appointment by phoning 345-7777. Scrip eligibility is reviewed every 12 months, and must be done in person at Senior Solutions' State Street office or prior to scrip distribution at the Boise Senior Activities Center, in which case a scrip participant must be at the center no later than 7:30 a.m. the day of distribution. A new I.D. card may be issued at this time.

***Each scrip coupon is good for \$1.00 and the coupons come in packets of 15. Each packet costs an individual \$7.00 and is good for \$15.00 worth of rides. Individuals may currently purchase a maximum of 6 packets each month, for a total cost to them of \$42.00, which provides \$90.00 worth of rides. Scrip must be purchased in increments of \$7.00 (\$7.00 minimum/\$42.00 maximum).*** Checks, money orders and cash are accepted. We do not accept credit or debit cards.

***Boise City scrip coupons are distributed the first working day of each month at the Boise Senior Activities Center, 690 Robbins Road, behind the Elk's Rehabilitation Hospital.*** Beginning at 7:30 a.m., scrip I.D. cards are checked to make sure they are valid. Valid I.D. cards are then drawn randomly, beginning at 8:00 a.m. Participants may purchase scrip coupons in the order in which scrip I.D. cards are drawn.

***Individuals must be in attendance, or have sent a representative, to be eligible for the drawing.*** A person may pick up scrip coupons for other eligible individuals if the person picking up the scrip has the other individuals' valid I.D. cards.

Distribution continues for as long as the month's allocation of coupons lasts. If public demand is in excess of the amount of scrip available that month, names and numbers will be taken from remaining scrip I.D. cards and placed on a list. The following month, these individuals' names will be called first.

Boise City scrip coupons are not redeemable for cash, nor will Senior Solutions make refunds for unused scrip coupons. City scrip coupons are non-transferable.

Neither Senior Solutions nor the City of Boise is responsible for lost or stolen scrip coupons.

Scrip procedures are subject to change or adjustments as conditions warrant. For further information, phone Senior Solutions at 345-7777.
